

STUDY BUSINESS IN FRANCE

Offered in collaboration with the Université d'Angers, ASU students take classes with Angers business students and learn international business skills while experiencing French culture and language.

Students live on campus and have the cultural experience of longer study abroad programs with the added benefit of travel and excursions with other ASU students. Excursions include visits to landmarks in Angers, the Loire Valley and Paris. The program starts and ends at the train station in Angers, France.

Summary of Program credit:

BUS 3045: Introduction to French Culture for Business Students (3 Semester hours)

MKT 3540: International Brand Management and New Product Development (3 semester hours)

FIN 4750: International Business Finance (3 semester hours).

All three courses count as IB electives (major, approved, required or other), HOS electives,

COB electives or upper level electives, and fulfill the Global Issues requirement.

MKT 3540 fulfills a marketing elective. FIN 4750 is a Finance Set 1 elective.

*Students <u>must take a minimum of 6 semester</u> <u>hours</u>, including BUS 3045 and at least one other course. *

Students can earn a total of 9 semester hours.
